For the past few years, a joint committee consisting of representatives from the Association for Information Systems (AIS), the Association for Computing Machinery (ACM), the Data Processing Management Association (DPMA) have been developing a Model Curriculum for Undergraduate Degree Programs in Information Systems. The committee report contains a summary of the objectives and rationale for the curriculum, recommended courses, prerequisite requirements and exit characteristics of graduates. A detailed and complete body of knowledge for the computing professions is defined along with the expected achievement levels for graduates from IS programs.
